

The New Titles List website complements the Library's Online Library Catalog. Using the New Titles List, you can see what materials have been recently added to the Library. To access the New Titles List, go to <http://www.library.uiuc.edu/newtitles/>

## Searching the New Titles List

There are two approaches to retrieving a list of the items recently added to the University Library – use the default settings or create a custom search.

### Default Search

To use the default search settings, go to <http://www.library.uiuc.edu/newtitles/> and click “Display Search Results.” at the bottom of the page. The retrieved list will contain items that have become available in the Library during the past 14 days.

### Custom Search

To create a custom search, go to <http://www.library.uiuc.edu/newtitles/> and set any or all of the following to settings other than the default:

**Select Libraries:** The default setting is All Libraries. You can specify instead a specific library or a combination of libraries.

**Select Call Numbers:** The default setting is All Call Numbers. You can specify instead specific Dewey Decimal System call number sets. At this time it is not possible to specify specific Library of Congress or Superintendent of Documents call numbers.

**Select Date:** The default setting is the Past 14 Days. You can choose a different time period. The date range refers to when the items became available in the Library, not when they were published.

**Select Sorting:** The default setting is to sort the results by Call Number. You can choose author or title sorting instead.

After choosing your desired settings, click “Display Search Results.”

## **Creating an RSS Feed for a Search**

In addition to manually searching the New Titles List, it is possible to create an RSS Feed that will automatically alert you to new items in the Library. To do so, create a Custom Search and then click “Create RSS Link.” You can add the resulting RSS link to your RSS Reader.

## **Linking to a Search**

In addition to manually searching the New Titles List, it is possible to create an HTML link that will automatically retrieve a set of custom results. To do so, create a Custom Search and then click “Create HTML Link.” You can bookmark the resulting link or embed it in a webpage.
